SUMMARY TABLES

The Bay Area Open Space Council (www.openspacecouncil.org) and GreenInfo Network (www.greeninfo.org) have completed an update to the Bay Area Protected Areas Database (BPAD). The information in the database is generally current to February 2014. The source information is a GIS database.

This document contains tables summarizing acreage information for the following attributes by county and for region:

- Total land/water areas (land, water)
- Fee/Easement status (fee, easement)
- Access status (open to public, restricted/open with permits, no public access, unknown)
- Level of agency (federal, state, county, city, special district, non-profit, other, unknown)
